


### **Participation report: Spring 2021**



## Assessment ACTION PLANS

### **Example: Cross-listed courses--challenges and opportunities.**

- Different CRNs: Splitting assessments as if courses were taught into separate classrooms
- Different disciplines, preparations, different results.
- Students who signed up under "discipline X" meet the threshold whereas those who signed up under "discipline Y" do not.
- Solution: Make material more accessible to students signing up from a variety of disciplines.


