

# PACE - PATCH Articulation

The HonCC Early Childhood Education program includes a noncredit program, PACE (Professional and Career Education for Early Childhood). PACE workshops are offered in a non-credit workshop format of sixteen 3-hour class sessions. Participants who complete all sixteen workshops in a course with a score of 70% or better are eligible for college credit. Participants who have completed the PATCH (People Attentive to Children) workshops below in the right column (and passed the assessment) may apply for a waiver of the equivalent PACE ECED 170 workshops.
