Financial Aid will pay for student charges in the following order: home campus tuition, student activity fees, publication fees, other UH campus' tuition, dorm charges, meal plans, and any other mandatory fees if authorized. Students are responsible for any unpaid charges on their student account.

Students who are awarded financial aid and do not plan to attend Honolulu CC must notify the Financial Aid Office in writing AND drop all courses before the first day of the semester. Students who fail to do so will be held responsible for any charges incurred and financial aid disbursed.
