UH-Mānoa Major Requirements for Shidler College of Business (BBA):

Admissions:

- **60 credits of college-level work** (junior standing) – recommend getting the AA
- **Minimum cumulative Grade-Point Average (GPA) of 2.50 in all course grades**
- **Minimum grade of "C" in ICS 101:**"Tools for the Information Age".
- **Completion of pre-business core courses with a minimum combined GPA of 2.50** with no grade below "C" ("C-" grade will not be accepted). Courses in the pre-business core may be repeated only if the grade earned is below "C-" or below. If courses are repeated, then ALL Non-UH Mānoa grades will be factored into the pre-business and cumulative GPA calculation.

UHM Shidler College of Business Notes:

- Shidler has four different options to fulfill the Hawaiian/Second Language/Culture requirement: 1) Four semesters of one language (202 equivalent); 2) Four semesters of culture courses (single culture group); 3) A mix of language and culture classes (4 courses; language and culture classes do not need to be from the same cultural group); 4) Take 12 credits of Study Abroad in Fall or Spring.
- Business Major Options: Accounting, Marketing, Management Information Systems, Management, Finance, Entrepreneurship, Human Resource Management, International Business (Double-Major only)

- All admission requirements must be completed the semester before entering the Shidler College of Business. Only courses completed during the first summer session at UH Mānoa will be accepted for Fall admission. No exceptions.
- If courses are repeated, then all non-UH Mānoa grades will be factored into the cumulative and pre-business GPA calculation. Starting Fall 2012, UH Mānoa Grade Replacement Policy will be in effect for any repeated UH Mānoa courses.
- Students who are enrolled in pre-business core classes at the time of application will be issued a tentative decision that will be finalized when final semester grades are posted.
- Shidler has an internship program that can be taken for academic credits.

University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Transfer Admission Requirements:

- 24 transferable semester credits or 12 transferable semester credits completed and have at least 12 transferable semester credits in progress
- Cumulative transfer GPA: 2.0 for residents; 2.5 for non-residents
- If you do not have 24 transferable credits, admission will be based on both your college and high school work.

UH-Mānoa Admission Deadlines

January 5	Fall semester applications due for international applicants and for priority consideration
March 1	All fall admission applications due
September 1	Spring semester applications due for international applicants and for priority consideration
October 1	All spring admission applications due
