This exciting sector continues to deliver breakthroughs in solid-state technology (transistors, integrated circuits, VLSI chips, microprocessors, lasers, optical fibers), which in turn fuel the unprecedented revolution in telecommunications (the Internet, wireless and digital signal processing), computers (neural network, distributed, intelligent), instrumentation (biomedical, intelligent), and many other related areas.

University of Hawai‘i at Mānoa Transfer Admission Requirements:

- 24 transferable semester credits or 12 transferable semester credits completed and have at least 12 transferable semester credits in progress
- Cumulative transfer GPA: 2.0 for residents; 2.5 for non-residents
- If you do not have 24 transferable credits, admission will be based on both your college and high school work.

January 5	Fall semester applications due for international applicants and for priority consideration
March 1	All fall admission applications due
September 1	Spring semester applications due for international applicants and for priority consideration
October 1	All spring admission applications due
