- Admissions for Transfer Students: Min. entrance GPA of 3.0 and have taken FSHN 185 (with a “B” or better) and CHEM 161/161L, CHEM 162/162L, PHYL 141/141L and 142/142L, and MATH 140 (or higher) (with a “C” or better.)
- Minimum major credits: Sports and Wellness Option = 79, Pre-Professional Option = 72, Dietetics Option = 103
