UH-Mānoa Major Requirements for BS Nursing Admission:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Admissions: Competitive
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FALL Only: January 5th deadline – Nursing CAS application required http://www.nursingcas.org/
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 (competitive cum gpa = 3.9)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum C grade (not C-) in all prerequisite courses (competitive gpa for pre-reqs = 4.0)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appropriate Test Scores on either the TEAS-V Exam or the NLN-PAX Exam http://nursing.hawaii.edu/nursing-bachelor/bs/how-to-apply/
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Only 6 credits within the prerequisites (listed below) may be repeated, the last grade will be used, not the best.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least 16 credits of prerequisites (listed below) must be completed at the time of application. These 16 credits must include at least one PHYL lecture and lab course and MICR 130. All remaining prerequisites may be in progress during the semester of application.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • B grade or better for all PHYL lectures/labs, MICR 130, and FS/FQ course. C grade or better for all other pre-reqs.

- The TEAS-V exam is offered at the KCC testing center (let KCC testing center know that the exam is for UH Manoa application so you do not have to wait for the 3-month grace period): <http://www2.hawaii.edu/~kcctest/teas.html>
- Food Science and Human Nutrition (FSHN 185) and Statistics (Math 115, Psy 225, Soc 225) is not built into the nursing curriculum, but it is required, so it is advised that the student take it prior to the start of the program.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cumulative transfer GPA: 2.0 for residents; 2.5 for non-residents 	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you do not have 24 transferable credits, admission will be based on both your college and high school work.

January 5	Fall semester applications due for international applicants and for priority consideration. NURSING APPLICATION DUE
March 1	All fall admission applications due
September 1	Spring semester applications due for international applicants and for priority consideration
October 1	All spring admission applications due
