## UH Mānoa Admissions Requirements for Psychology:

- Complete PSY 100, PSY 212, PSY 225 or SOCS 225 with ‘C’ or higher.
- Have a GPA of 2.5 or higher in all Psychology courses completed, whether at UH Mānoa or elsewhere.

Min major credits: 36

Minimum C grade (not C-) in all courses

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## University of Hawai'i at Mānoa Transfer Admission Requirements:

- 24 transferable semester credits or 12 transferable semester credits completed and have at least 12 transferable semester credits in progress
- Cumulative transfer GPA: 2.0 for residents; 2.5 for non-residents
- If you do not have 24 transferable credits, admission will be based on both your college and high school work.

<b>January 5</b>	Fall semester applications due for international applicants and for priority consideration
<b>March 1</b>	All fall admission applications due
<b>September 1</b>	Spring semester applications due for international applicants and for priority consideration
<b>October 1</b>	All spring admission applications due
