University of Hawai‘i – West Oahu Transfer Admission Requirements:

- 24 transferable college-level semester credits from a regionally accredited institution
- Minimum 2.0 GPA
- Students with fewer than 24 college-level semester credits, or who previously attended a non-regionally accredited institution, will be evaluated under freshmen admission requirements.

UH West Oahu Admission Deadlines

March 1	Fall semester applications due for priority consideration
May 1	Fall semester applications due for international applicants
July 1	Fall admission applications due (final)
October 1	Spring semester applications due for international applicants and for priority consideration
December 1	All spring admission applications due
