

Liberal Arts - Exploratory Majors

Exploratory majors provide a starting point to connect and familiarize yourself with Liberal Arts offerings. Exploratory majors provide structure and help you decide on choices related to your interests to support your success.

At Honolulu Community College, Exploratory Majors are designed primarily for Liberal Arts students who are unclear as to what they want to do, but have some idea of the general area they want to study. Exploratory Majors have a defined set of courses that are applicable to the students' terminal or transfer degrees. Within a well-defined set timeframe, students are counseled into a specific major or concentration.

The Exploratory Majors are **not degrees that students can graduate with**. At the end of completing 30 credits (100 level or higher), students are required to meet with a Liberal Arts counselor to discuss selecting a major.
