Week of July 22nd, 2019

Nimitz Highway between Alakea Street and Awa Street

- The left westbound lane may be closed between 6:30pm and 8pm nightly Monday evening through Thursday evening.
- The two left westbound lanes may be closed between 8pm and 5am nightly Monday evening through Friday morning.
- The left eastbound lane may be closed between 5:30pm and 7pm nightly Monday evening through Thursday evening.
- The two left eastbound lanes may be closed between 7pm and 4am nightly Monday evening through Friday morning.
- The left turn from Aloha Tower Drive at Fort Street may be closed 7pm to 5am nightly Monday evening through Friday morning. The adjacent crosswalk will also be closed with pedestrians rerouted to Bishop Street/Nimitz Highway crosswalk.

Kaaahi Street between Dillingham Boulevard and Kaaahi Place

- No on-street parking from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday night through Friday morning.
