How To Apply

Submit a Free Application for Federal Student (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov

Honolulu Community College Federal School Code is **001612**

Priority Dates

March 1st for Fall semester, Oct. 1st for Spring semester.

Submit your FAFSA and all necessary paperwork by this date to ensure that you get the most favorable financial aid package possible.

Honolulu CC will review your FAFSA information to determine if anything additional is needed to complete your financial aid file.

Check your myUH Portal for additional information and financial aid status.

Receive Award Notification

You will be notified via your hawaii.edu email. Your eligibility will be based on your Cost of Attendance (COA), Expected Family Contribution (EFC), and funds available. Your award will be delayed if your financial aid file is incomplete.

This is a yearly process. Applications are available on October 1st for the following school year.
